

Drawstring Bag to keep your story puppets safe:

This simple pattern will help you make a sweet bag to store all your puppets with the story sheet. Use any scraps of DK wool and use your creativity to make it original.



Finished Size: 6 x 6 in/15 x 15 cm

Materials: small amount of DK yarn

4mm needles

1 yard of cord or ribbon

Using any colour DK yarn and 4mm needles, CO 60sts.

Work 4 rows in stocking stitch.

Next: Turning Row: knit

Work in stocking stitch until bag meas 6in/15cm ending on a purl row.

Cast off.

Darn in loose yarn ends.

Fold casing to WS of work along turning row and slip stitch in place.

Fold bag in half lengthwise and sew side seam leaving the casing holes unstitched.

Sew bottom seam.

Thread a length of cord or ribbon through the casing and knot long ends.
